What is Educators Rising?

Educators Rising cultivates highly skilled educators by guiding young people on a path to becoming accomplished teachers, beginning in high school and extending through college and into the profession.

Do I need to join Educators Rising?

In order to receive the Careers in Education Honor Cord, you must hold membership in Educators Rising.

What courses am I required to take?

Students in the pathway will follow a sequence of required courses, some are college-level and will provide the opportunity to earn college credits through the Community College System of New Hampshire or through Southern New Hampshire University:

Am I required to complete an internship?

No. Any student can be in the Careers in Education Pathway. However, completion of an internship or participation in the Careers in Education Program at Pinkerton Academy is required to receive an honor cord.

What are the honor cord requirements for the Careers in Education Pathway?

An honor cord signifying your academic achievement in the Careers in Education Pathway will be awarded to students who complete the following requirements:

- ✓ Completion of required and elective courses in the pathway with an overall 3.0 GPA
- ✓ Minimum overall 2.5 GPA in all high school courses
- ✓ Successful completion of an internship or approved job shadowing experience
- ✓ Membership in Educators Rising
