

Pelham High School Recovery Plan 2020-2021

In Course Recovery: Competency recovery is for all students. It is offered throughout the course. Students must complete all formatives before they will be given the opportunity to complete a competency recovery assessment or plan. Students are expected to complete a ***Competency Recovery Plan Request*** form within one week of notification of the grade (posted). This form will include the plan and the deadline for submission. The deadline will be two weeks after the recovery plan is established.

End of Course Recovery: Course recovery is available to students at the end of a course. Students with a 50-64 overall average at the conclusion of the course will have the opportunity to attend course recovery with their teacher during the designated times.

Pelham High School Late Grade Policy for 2020-2021

Formatives: Late formatives will receive no credit. They will need to be completed as part of a recovery plan and handed in prior to recovery being assessed.

Summatives: A summative that is submitted for assessment after the due date will lose 10 pts. for each day it is late up to 50 points. Any summative submitted after the due date is not eligible for recovery, unless there are extenuating circumstances that will be subject to teacher discretion. Summatives that are to be taken within the classroom will be taken on the date designated by the teacher. They cannot be taken at a later time.

***Please see Pelham High School Student Handbook about the submission of work and making up assessments when a student has an excused absence from school.

College Credit Courses

Competency recovery cannot be applied to the college grade. However, the same student enrolled in this college-level course can get competency recovery applied to his/her high school grade. Therefore, a student may have two different grades for that course—a college grade and high school grade.
