It is the belief of the Board that any student who is capable of, and wishes to do, college-level work while in high school should be permitted to do so and shall be given assistance in enrolling in advanced courses.

Any student whose admission to a college-level course is recommended by his counselor may enroll in a course at an approved college for college credit at no cost to the District. A student who wishes to receive high school credit for the course may make this request under Policy IMBC Alternative Credit Options.
