PELHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY JICC – STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

Category: Recommended

Students using District transportation must understand that they are under the jurisdiction of the School from the time they board the bus until they exit the bus.

The bus driver is in charge of the students on the bus. Continued disorderly conduct or persistent refusal to follow the direction of the drive shall be sufficient reasons for a student to be denied the privilege of transportation in accordance with the regulations of the Board.

The bus driver is responsible for the orderly conduct of the students transported. Each driver has the support of the Board in maintaining good conduct on the bus. If a student is to lose the privilege of riding the bus, advance warning will be given to the parent or legal guardian, except for instances of extreme misconduct that may warrant immediate removal of privileges.

The Superintendent or his/her designee will develop rules for conduct on buses, and these shall be printed in each Student Handbook.
