PELHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY JICE – STUDENT PUBLICATIONS

Category: Recommended

School-sponsored student prepared media publications may be authorized by the Board. All such media publications will conform to rules established by the Superintendent and the building principal. Any media publication not approved by the Board will not be considered a school media publication, and it shall not be distributed on school property.

All school media publications will be under the supervision of the school principal or his/her designee. The principal or his/her designee has the right to limit or edit the contents of any school publication based on the following standards: Nothing published in student publications will be libelous, slanderous, obscene, advocate illegal activities, infringe on copyrighted material, or otherwise cause substantial disruption to school activities and functions. The school principal or his/her designee will review all school-sponsored publications before they are printed, posted or distributed to ensure the publication conforms to these standards.
