Bullying - The state of New Hampshire has a specific definition of bullying. Key elements include:

- An imbalance of power.
- Only student interactions with other students.
- Either a single incident or a pattern of behavior.
- Things that cause physical harm, property damage, emotional distress, interference with educational opportunities, a hostile educational environment, or a substantial disruption of school.
