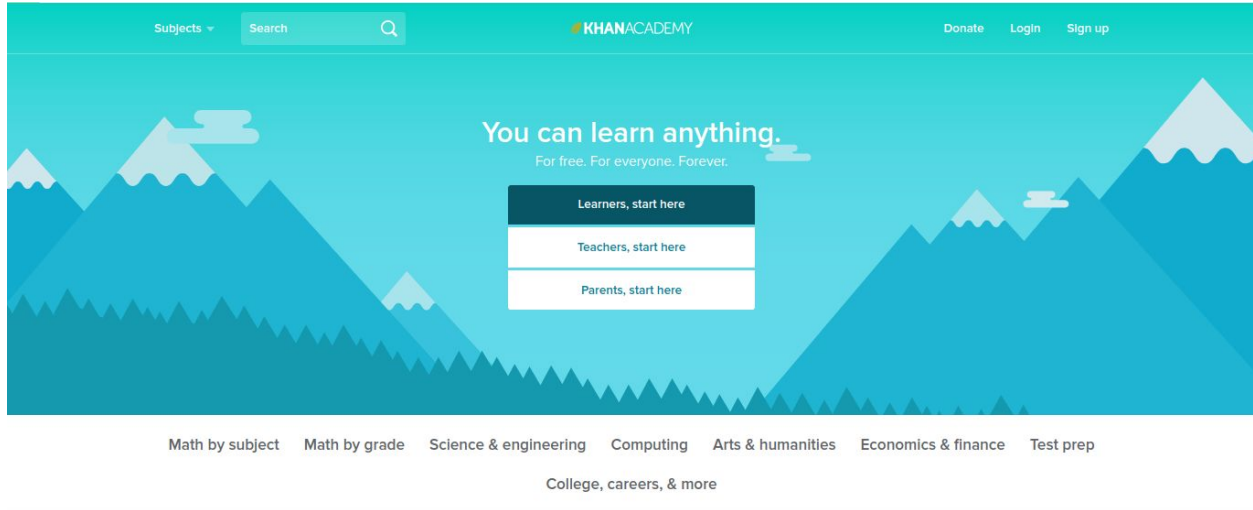
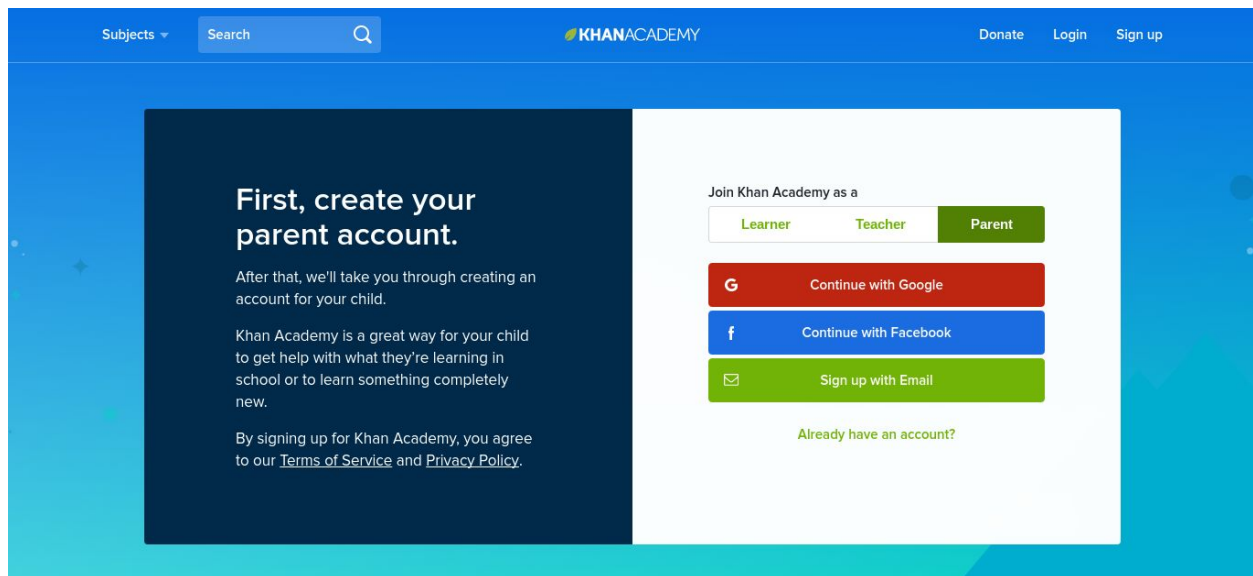


# Directions For Parents

  - a. When signing in with Google a popup will appear asking if you would like to share some information with Khanacademy, Select Yes
    - i. The same will occur if signing in through facebook

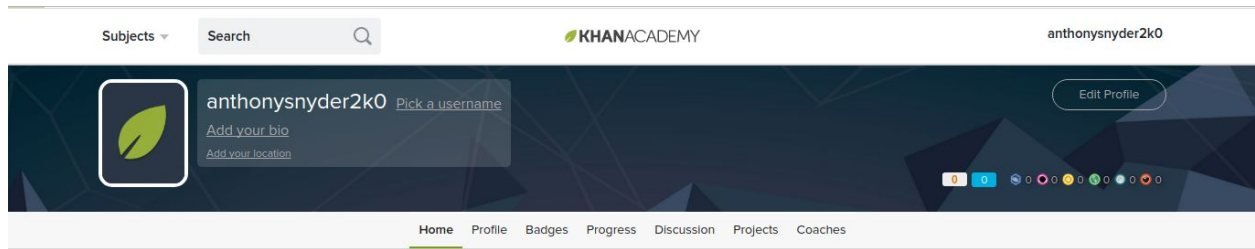

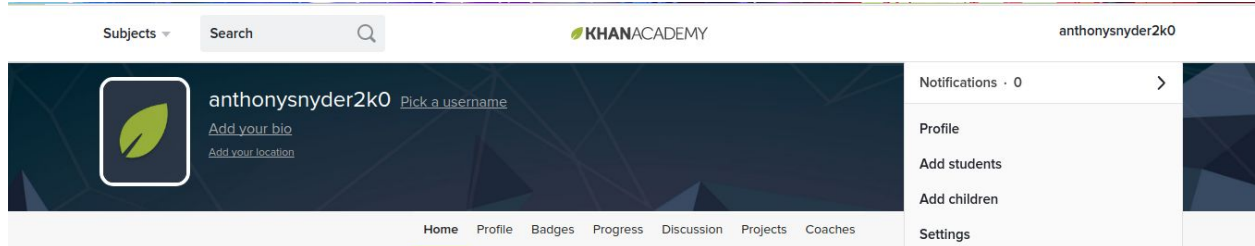
