What are the honor cord requirements for the Studio Art Pathway?

An honor cord signifying your academic achievement in the Studio Art Pathway will be awarded to students who complete the following requirements:

- Completion of required and elective courses in the Studio Art Pathway with an overall 3.0 GPA
- Minimum overall 2.5 GPA in all high school courses
- Portfolio composed of a culmination of artwork created throughout the pathway.
- Studio Art students are required to submit a written artist's statement.
